### **Voter Registration**

To register or update a registration online, visit [govotetn.com](http://govotetn.com). By mail applications are also available at all USPS locations and the Public Library. The Montgomery County Election Commission is open for in-person voter registration at the location and hours listed below.

Office Hours: Monday – Friday - 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.  
Extended office hours for voter registration assistance will be held on Saturday, June 27, 2020, from 9 a.m. to 12:00 Noon.

If you attempted to register to vote at the Department of Safety, Department of Human Services, another state agency, or if you registered by mail but you have not received a voter registration card, you should contact our office immediately at 931-648-5707.

The last day to register to vote for the August 6, 2020 election is **July 7, 2020**.

### **Early Voting**

Early Voting by personal appearance (no reason required) at the Election Commission Office will be **July 17 – August 1, 2020**.

### **Write in Candidates**

Anyone still interested in seeking nomination by write-in ballot for offices to be elected in the August 6, 2020 election shall complete a notice requesting such person's ballots be counted no later than **June 17, 2020 at 12:00 Noon**. Forms are available at the Election Commission office.

### **Inaccessible Polling Place**

Any elderly voter or voter with a disability that deems their polling location as inaccessible has the right to vote early or at the Election Commission Office on Election Day. To vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day, such voters must complete an affidavit at the Election Commission Office, no later than July 27, 2020. If you need voter assistance due to a disability, call 931-648-5707.

### **Photo ID Law**

Federal or Tennessee State government issued photo ID is now required to vote, unless an exception applies. College IDs will not be accepted. To learn more about the new law and its exceptions, go to [www.mcgtm.org/election](http://www.mcgtm.org/election)

\*\* If you registered by-mail and wish to vote absentee, you must present a Federal or Tennessee State issued photo ID in person to the Election Office prior to completing the absentee ballot request form.
