Project Description:

With the addition of a new Circuit Court Judge, the Courts Center, which was originally completed in 2002, underwent a major renovation adding two new courtrooms to the vacant 3rd floor area. With the two new courtrooms on the 3rd floor completed, space will remain available for the future final two court rooms that will fully finish out the available space within this facility. A programmatic detailed evaluation was completed on the existing Courts Center to evaluate exterior leaks and to identify underutilized spaces within the current Courts Center. Minor office renovations were also completed to accommodate the growing number of employees that work inside the Courts Center.
