Montgomery County, TN. Stormwater Maintenance Agreement Policy

- 1.) A Stormwater Maintenance Agreement is required for all development sites that have stormwater control structures or Best Management Practices (BMPs) installed. A Stormwater Maintenance Agreement must be filed with the Montgomery County Register of Deeds and an original copy of the filed agreement submitted to the Montgomery County Building and Codes Department before a development permit will be issued.
- 3.) Montgomery County Stormwater Inspectors may perform periodic inspections of storm water structures in order to determine that the structures are being maintained in proper operating condition. Montgomery County will order corrective actions for components of the system that are determined to be improperly maintained.
